C3 INDEX 2017 FIRST QUARTER SCORE: 2.08 GPA

The Master Builders' Association C3 Index results for the recent business quarter that closed March 31, 2017, indicate that the grade point average for the commercial construction industry in southwestern Pennsylvania is: **2.08 on a scale of 4.0**. This C grade point average is a result of construction firms responding with steady increases in optimism for the current and future business climate. The small decrease in backlog will likely show improvement over the coming months with the major increase in bidding activity.

SUMMARY

The steady increases in the C3 Index for the 1st quarter of 2017 does not come as a surprise. As previously projected, bidding activity has begun to increase, as the projects being drawn by architects over the past three quarters are finally hitting the bid phase. The 2017 outlook remains bright and we look forward to seeing continued success for our members.
