

Dwight Kuhn was feeling unusually fatigued, but never expected the diagnosis that came after a routine annual physical in April 2017 – acute myeloid leukemia (AML). AML is a blood and bone marrow cancer that can quickly spread to other parts of the body.

To date, Dwight has undergone three treatments of intense chemotherapy and has needed 40 units of blood and 40 units of platelets. His AML is currently in remission, but he has myelodysplastic syndromes (MDS), a precursor to AML. He continues to need blood transfusions every two weeks to keep up his strength.

Now retired, Dwight served the regional construction industry for more than four decades, and his friends at the Master Builders' Association of Western PA are hosting a replenishment blood drive in his honor.
