The Construction Advancement Program of Western Pennsylvania Fund (CAP) is a service organization established in 1961 by the Master Builders' Association of Western Pennsylvania, Inc. (MBA) to address the needs of contractors engaged in commercial, institutional, and industrial construction.

One-Year \$5,000 Scholarship

Qualifications

1. Any undergraduate student in IUP's safety, health, and environmental applied sciences major, SRU's safety management major or Thiel College environmental safety management major and meeting the following qualification criteria is eligible to apply.
2. Applicants must have completed thirty (30) credit hours of undergraduate education and be a full-time student pursuing a degree in the field of safety.
3. Applicants must submit complete university transcripts of grades to date.
4. Scholarship awards are competitive and may be based on:
 - Academic standing as determined by university grades in the Department.
 - Career choice as it relates to the construction industry.
 - Extracurricular activities and leadership in both high school and college.
5. Family members of the CAP and MBA staff and members of the CAP Scholarship Committee will not be eligible for the awards.

Selections

1. Applicants are required to submit a **personal letter** giving qualifications for the scholarship, including a statement concerning their educational and career goals, and detailing their construction work experience.
2. Applicants must submit a completed application and supporting documents within the specified deadline to receive consideration for the scholarship.

Retention

1. The award will be forfeited if the applicant leaves the field of safety at IUP, Thiel or SRU.
2. Any change in the educational status of the scholarship recipient must be reported to the Scholarship Committee.

Deadline

The completed application and supporting documents must be submitted **no later than December 2, 2024**, to the CAP/MBA Safety Scholarship Committee, 631 Iron City Drive, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15205 or info@mbawpa.org.

The award will be made payable to the individual winner.

CAP and MBA will have the right to revise, change or cancel the scholarship award program, as it deems necessary.
